



IMMIGRATION SERVICES

Do you have an immigration question? Come to the morning “walk-in” time on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday from 8:30 to 9:30 a.m. No appointment’s necessary, but it’s best to come early.

PASSPORT PHOTOS are available without an appointment Monday -- Friday from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

All other immigration services are by appointment only. The International Institute can help you fill out many immigration forms quickly and correctly. To schedule an appointment, please come early to the morning “walk-in” time on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday from 8:30 to 9:30 a.m.

The Institute does not give out immigration forms. But a printed copy of the 100 Questions and Answers for the Naturalization (citizenship) test is available for \$2 at the 2nd floor reception desk.

Appointment at Immigration office: You must have an appointment to go to the U.S. Immigration office downtown. You can make an appointment at this website: www.infopass.uscis.gov. Instructions are written in English, Spanish, Russian, Arabic, Vietnamese, French, Chinese, Creole, Tagalog, Korean, Polish, and Portuguese. Public libraries have computers you can use for free, or you can ask a friend to help you.

Passports for U.S. citizens:

To get a U.S. passport for the first time, citizens must apply in person at certain U.S. Post Offices. Passports may be renewed on-line at www.travel.state.gov. U.S. passport information: 1-877-487-2778.
